- Tornado watch or warning thirty minutes before any church function - function cancelled. If a program is in progress & a warning is issued, appropriate shelter at the church will be sought immediately.
- Worship service cancellation (other than tornado watch or warning) will be determined by the pastor & Vice President of Consistory.
- Event cancellation (other than tornado watch or warning) will be determined by the organizer of the event. If that person is not available, the ministry staff will make the determination.
- If Holland Public Schools are closed or after school activities cancelled due to weather, evening church activities will be cancelled.
- Cancellations/postponements will be broadcast on television stations WWMT Channel 3, WOOD Channel 8, WZZM Channel 13 and radio stations WHTC 1450 AM and WJQK 99.3 FM.

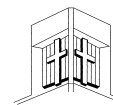
