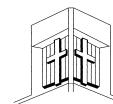

- That members of the Trinity team and other teams returning will not fall back into normalcy but as a result of the Guatemala experience will be filled with a deeper personal relationship with Jesus Christ and that this will make a noticeable difference in their witness to others
- That needed medical and construction supplies will arrive without government delay, confiscation and heavy tariffs
- That government officials will have a change of heart and not make villagers suspicious of missionary efforts
- For the Smiths as an isolated missionary family and the unique stress that places on their family dynamics and relationships
- For Erin, the summer intern, as she comes to the end of her time there, plans to return to the states for continued education and seek God's direction for her future
- For Estuardo as despite being paralyzed from the waist down he continues to travel the rutted two track roads searching for more villages receptive to medical help and an openness to listen to the Jesus film
