

Through a combination of creative evangelism, Bible study, mentoring, recreation, academic support and a lot of wholesome fun, we desire to help youth successfully live out biblical principles and reach their God-given potential.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Camp Rock meets at Trinity Church throughout the summer. The Rock Staff is incredible and gives 110% to the kids every day. We would like to provide them (15 people) with lunch Mon. - Thurs. every week through mid-August. Lunches can be as simple or extravagant as you wish. You are invited to serve the lunch on the day you bring it (food should arrive at church by 11am), or you may drop the food off and the Trinity staff will take care of serving. A sign up sheet is available at the information counter near the office - individuals, groups of friends, Bible Study groups, Turning Pages, choir, youth groups, etc. are encouraged to sign up. - PRAY!!! Pray that God will move this summer in the lives of students and staff. Pray that the gospel would go forth in each of our lives. Pray for the health and unity of the staff. Pray for safety and protection.
- Volunteers are always welcome, either for a morning, an afternoon or all day. Mornings consist of worship, small groups, Bible study, etc. The campers typically go on fun outings in the afternoon. You are welcome to join them!

with the cheetahs.


When you are stressed, float awhile.
