The Suicide Prevention Coalition of Kent and Ottawa Counties would like to formally invite you to a workshop on equipping, implementing and sustaining churches for suicide prevention through mental illness awareness and suicide prevention education programming.

Religious congregations are defined by their focus on worship, religious beliefs and teachings - but they can also be a safety net for people who need emotional support and resources.

The goal for putting this training together is to challenge the faith communities to join in on sharing resources, learn more about suicide warning signs and work to reduce stigma within your congregation.

In this 3-hour training, attendees will be educated in mental health and suicide prevention through the **be nice.** Program, created and taught by the Mental Health Foundation of West Michigan and accompanied by faith leader Pastor Jim Liske, who helped create the curriculum.

## **Quarters for Calcutta**



“Quarters for Calcutta” is a program dedicated to helping some of the poorest children in the world - street children in the slums of Calcutta, India. Each day a bus operated by the Good News Children’s Education Mission stops at one of Calcutta’s

dumps to pick up young children of families who make their living there by picking through the refuse. The children are transported to a Christian day school where they are welcomed by a loving teaching staff. They are bathed and receive fresh, clean clothes if needed. They are taught by dedicated Christian teachers. Each day they receive a hot lunch, one that may be their only hot meal that day. The cost of the meal is approximately 25 cents (US) per child. Hence the name “Quarters for Calcutta.” The program has been providing meals for Calcutta kids since 2002.

You and especially your children can be part of this mission effort by contributing your quarters. Because all money contributed to this program flows through a volunteer organization, every penny goes to the program in India. 100% of your donation will actually go to Calcutta to help the kids. Generous people care about these kids as much as you do. They donate their time and money to cover all the administrative costs of running this program.
