## The 9th Commandment given to God's people at Mt Sinai "YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOR" Exodus 20:16

Heidelberg Catechism Q & A112. Q.What is required

in the ninth commandment?

A. I must not give false testimony against anyone,

twist no one's words, not gossip or slander,

nor condemn or join in condemning anyone

rashly and unheard. 1

Rather, I must avoid all lying and deceit

as the devil's own works,

under penalty of God's heavy wrath. 2

In court and everywhere else,

I must love the truth, <sup>3</sup>

speak and confess it honestly,

and do what I can

to defend and promote

my neighbour's honour and reputation. 4
