Since, then, we know what it is to fear the Lord, we try to persuade men. What we are is plain to God, and I hope it is also plain to your conscience. 12 We are not trying to commend ourselves to you again, but are giving you an opportunity to take pride in us, so that you can answer those who take pride in what is seen rather than in what is in the heart. ¹³ If we are out of our mind, it is for the sake of God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. 14 For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. 15 And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

¹⁶ So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. ¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. ²¹ God made him who had no sin to be sin a for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

The number after each item is the total (as of April 11) of what we have given out since we started 6 months ago. You can see which are the more popular items. There are 4 products for which we have another source. The diapers & wipes are supplied by a "Diaper Bank", and their service is so helpful. Also, the paper towels and toilet tissue are purchased by the case at Sam's Club. Gretchen Fisher picks them up for us when she purchases the supply for church use. Both are very popular and needed items, and much appreciated.

These 32 items are on the "shopping" list for clients to pick from. Each family can select 10 items each visit. Sometimes products are donated that are not on the list, and they do not go to waste. These items are on a separate list, and often are chosen as one of the 10 allowed items, and are appreciated. Aluminum foil and fabric softener were recently added to the list because of many requests. However, we do not add a lot of things to the list, as then we <u>must</u> have at least 5 of each available every week.

You, our Trinity family have been gracious and have kept the Closet supplied. There have been some weeks with concern, but by Wednesday our closet was stocked and we were ready to serve. The Care Closet needs are year round, so we will be open year round, and in advance, a big




Ladies Night Out concluded the season in April. An average of about 24 ladies gathered once a month for dinner, fellowship and hands-on service projects to benefit our community.
