## A Note From Your Stewardship Team

Although we are grateful that we spent less than we had budgeted in 2018, our receipts fell short of our actual expenses. This deficit was covered by our Cash Reserve Fund. On January 17, 2019 we received an insurance reimbursement for the claim we submitted as a result of the May 2018 lightning strike in the amount of \$9,857. This was deposited to replenish the Cash Reserve Fund.

Budgeted Amount	\$516,164.00
Actual Expenses	\$487,488.66
Receipts	\$455,485.14
Shortfall	- \$ 32,003.52

In 2018 we blessed those who needed a little extra help with \$6,471.00 from our Benevolent Fund. We also helped fund \$1347.00 through Camp Scholarships.

For the 2019 fiscal year, \$9,944.00/week is needed to meet our annual budget. In the spirit of transparency, it is our intention to communicate the status of our budget on a monthly basis. We thank you for your continued generosity as we carry out the ministry and mission of Christ's Church through Trinity.
