## Consistory Update

The consistory thanks the congregation for sharing with us during our recent townhall meeting. We also thank you for the prayers you have extended as we seek to discern God's will for Trinity.

Based on the input from the townhall, the consistory has decided to immediately seek a part-time Director of Children's Ministry. This position is expected to be in the 15-20 hour per week range. We are finalizing the job description and will begin the search very soon.

We also heard the desire by some to continue with the co-pastor model. The consistory recognizes that without significant annual withdrawals from the endowment funds, financially we can no longer support two full-time ordained pastors. Pastor Deb has committed to continue serving Trinity for the near term as we continue to seek to follow God's call for Trinity.

The consistory began the visioning process late in 2020 and will continue in 2021. We believe that all of your questions and suggestions are important to consider as we look to our future. During the visioning process, we will also look to the future use of our endowment funds. We will engage the congregation in this process as well. Please be lifting Trinity and our future ministry up in prayer as we seek God's leading.
