Message: Hmmm...Am I Judged Once?

OLD TESTAMENT READING: Isaiah 53:5

NEW TESTAMENT READING: Matthew 25:31-46

1. The Lord will judge (Hebrews 10:30b).

- For we know him who said, "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," and again, "The Lord will judge his people." ³¹ It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. (Hebrews 10:30-31).
- Know therefore that the LORD your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments. ¹⁰ But those who hate him he will repay to their face by destruction; he will not be slow to repay to their face those who hate him. ¹¹ Therefore, take care to follow the commands, decrees and laws I give you today. (Deuteronomy 7:9-11)
- "For the wages of sin is death..." (Romans 6:23a).

2. God is merciful. After the flood, God made a promise to Noah and his descendants:

Never again will I curse the ground because of human beings, even though every inclination of the human heart is evil from childhood. And never again will I destroy all living creatures, as I have done." (Genesis 8:21)

- The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. ⁹ He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever; (Psalm 103:8-9)

3. Although God is merciful, He is also just.

Message: *Hmmm...Am I Judged Once?*

- God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God (2 Corinthians 5:21)
- For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. (John 3:16-17)

If you want to see God's love - Look at the cross.

If you want to see God's wrath - Look at the cross.

If you want to see God's judgment - Look at the cross.

If you want to see God's mercy - Look at the cross.

4. Christ is the judge. (Matthews 25:31-46)

- “Come, you who are blessed by my father, take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.” (Matthew 25: 34)

For since the creation of the world, God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. (Romans 1:20)

- “Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels” (Matthew 25:41)

“They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might (2 Thessalonians 1:9).

‘He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’ or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.” (Revelation 21:4).
