### Study Questions Week 3

Ephesians 6:10-14

“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to withstand on that evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. 14 Stand therefore, and fasten the belt of truth around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place.”

1. What vital organs does a soldier's breastplate protect. In Jewish thought, what do these organs represent?
2. What does Proverbs 4:23 command us, regarding the heart? Why do you think this is necessary?
3. Why is it important to put on the Belt of Truth before putting on the Breastplate of Righteousness? What is the difference between truth and righteousness?
4. If your eyes, ears, and mind are gateways to your heart, what are some tactics that Satan uses to gain access to your heart? What is the result?
5. What is the definition of righteousness? Using your favorite search engine, or biblical resource – list Scripture that talks about what it means to be righteous. Give examples of imputed righteousness and imparted righteousness.



6. What happens to shame and guilt when righteousness is imputed to you? What does Satan want you to believe though?
