NEW TESTAMENT READING: Acts 17:24-28

God's Pre-Creation Activities

God was having fellowship with His Son, Jesus.

And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began" (John 17:5).

God was planning for His Church.

"and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery [Church], which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things" (Ephesians 3:9).

God was choosing the elect.

"For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight" (Ephesians 1:4).

God was planning for His future Kingdom.

"Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world'" (Matthew 25:34).

God was planning for the Savior of the world.

"For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, ¹⁹but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. ²⁰He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake" (1 Peter 1:18-20).
