Study Questions Week 4

*“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ **and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace**” (Ephesians 6:10-15).*

1. If you made a list of the most stressful events in your life, what would be on it? What stresses are you facing now?
2. Think about a time when you braced yourself for something stressful. Did your preparations soften the impact?
3. Give examples of peace offered by the world; peace offered by Satan; and peace offered by Christ.
4. What kinds of alternatives have you seen people drawn toward as a substitute for biblical peace?
5. What is the difference between peace WITH God and the peace OF God?



6. Read Ephesians 2:13-14. How does Paul emphasize the way peace with God should affect peace in our relationship with others?

7. Read 2 Corinthians 10:4-5. What are some areas of your life where you need to be on the offensive instead of the defensive, taking back ground from the enemy?

8. Read Philippians 4:6-7. List at least three specific things you can be grateful to God for despite whatever difficulty you are currently facing.
