Study Questions Week 5

*“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ **In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.**”*

1. Do you feel that the world is becoming more dangerous? How so? What makes you feel safe? Unsafe?
2. What are some spiritual doubts you have wrestled with? Describe a time when Satan leveraged a hardship to attack your faith.
3. God has already brought you through situations in which you felt fear and anxiety. Recall one of those situations and write down the story of God's faithfulness to you.
4. Several Scripture passages describe God as a shield. What does it mean to you that God is YOUR shield?
 - A. Psalm 3:3
 - B. Psalm 18:2
 - C. Psalm 28:7
 - D. Psalm 33:20
 - E. Psalm 84:11-12
 - F. Psalm 91:4
 - G. Psalm 115:9-11



5. Read Hebrews 11:1. What is the biblical definition of faith? What is the difference between belief and faith?
6. Hebrews 11 tells the story of heroes of the faith. What do you learn about how they utilized their faith in their experience? What would have happened if they had chosen not to move forward in faith?
 - Noah (vs. 7)
 - Abraham (vs. 8-10)
 - Sarah (vs. 11-12)
 - Moses (vs. 24-26)

Have you ever felt the need for more faith to do what you feel God is asking you to do?
7. At the end of his conversation with Thomas in John 20, Jesus said, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (vs. 29). What do those words mean to you? How do you see yourself in that promise?
8. Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-12. The Roman soldiers' shields were designed to link together for added protection against the enemy. They huddled in a circle with their shields hoisted over their heads to form a turtle shell when the flaming arrows started to fly. What does this say about how we should concern ourselves with building up the faith of others? How should active faith strengthen the Church?
