## Study Questions Week 6

“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.” (Ephesians 6:10-17).

1. What do you think is a favorite corner of peoples' minds where Satan tends to set up shop? Where are you most vulnerable to deception and misdirection?
2. On a scale of 1 to 10 (with 1 being “not hopeful at all” and 10 being “extremely hopeful”), how hopeful are you? Do you tend to be optimistic or pessimistic?
3. Are you waiting for God's deliverance? What is hard about waiting for “that day”? How can your waiting become more faith filled and productive?
4. The definition of salvation from the Lexham Theological Wordbook is: “Salvation is the rescue from a state of danger and the ‘restoration to wholeness and prosperity.’ In what ways have you experienced rescuing and restoration?
5. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:8. In what ways does our ultimate salvation in Christ give us hope and confidence even while living through the trials and difficulties of life? How does it inform our choices feelings, and actions? (See also Romans 8:23-24).



6. Salvation is not only about our future, It also affects the present. The fact that Jesus lives means our salvation flows into our everyday experiences. Our souls are saved daily as we experience the abundant life of Christ.
- Look up the word sanctification and write down the definition.
  - How does the sanctification process affect the mind?
  - Look up the word justification. What is the difference between sanctification and justification?
7. From the following verses, what is the importance of the mind to the believer's ability to function in health and victory?
- Isaiah 26:3-4
  - Romans 8:6-7
  - 1 Corinthians 14:20
  - Hebrews 8:10
  - 1 Peter 1:13-16
8. Read Psalm 139:1-6, 13-17. Which portions of David's psalm negate the following lies that Satan wants us to believe?
- I am unworthy
  - I am unloved
  - I am incapable
  - I am undesirable
  - I am unforgiveable
  - I am unknown
  - My life is insignificant
  - I am a mistake
  - I can lose my salvation
9. Read Psalm 139: 1-6, 13-17 and Ephesians 1 every single day and let the truth of who you are in Christ fill your heart and mind. How did wearing the "helmet of salvation" thwart Satan's attacks today?
