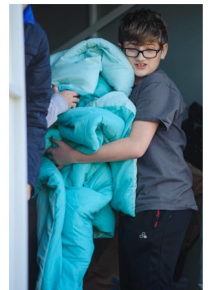

He set out with a mission, with each year growing more and more, people from all over joined together to help him and support his cause. Samuel knows that blankets get dirty and damaged when exposed to the elements after a while and wants to make sure those who need them will have one every year.
