
Do you need help hearing the service? We have a **T-loop** installed in our sanctuary. Please see the Sound Room Team if you need help connecting.

Song of Dedication | Our song of dedication this morning is *Facing a Task Unfinished*. In 1927, due to civil war and a difficult period in China's history, missionaries with China Inland Mission (CIM) were withdrawn from their stations. 12 CIM workers had been martyred along with five associates. In December of 1929, the director of CIM put out a call for 200 new workers within a 2 year period. Frank Houghton wrote *Facing a Task Unfinished* in support of the appeal for two hundred. By December 31, 1931, two hundred new missionaries set sail for China with all the money needed supplied.

Keith and Kristyn Getty chose this song for the 2016 Global Hymn Sing in which Christians around the world all sing the same hymn on the same date. On February 21, 2016, an estimated 1.1 million believers in 5400 churches across 100 countries in multiple languages sang this hymn. The hymn is sung to the tune of *The Church's One Foundation*, The Gettys wrote the chorus. Please meditate on the words as you sing them.
