Lent Sermon Series | The letter to the Romans is one of the apostle Paul's last letters, written to a community of faith at odds with one another. As Paul addresses the reality of division in the Roman church, he pens one of the most beautiful and rich statements of faith in the power of God in Christ to transform the lives of those "loved by God and called to be his own holy people" (Romans 1:7).

As we journey to Easter, let's listen to Paul's call to remember and believe the power of our God in Jesus to raise the dead and to transform enemies into beloved ones.
