We have several members on-call to help care for your little ones in the **nursery**. Please see one of the Greeters before the service who can help.

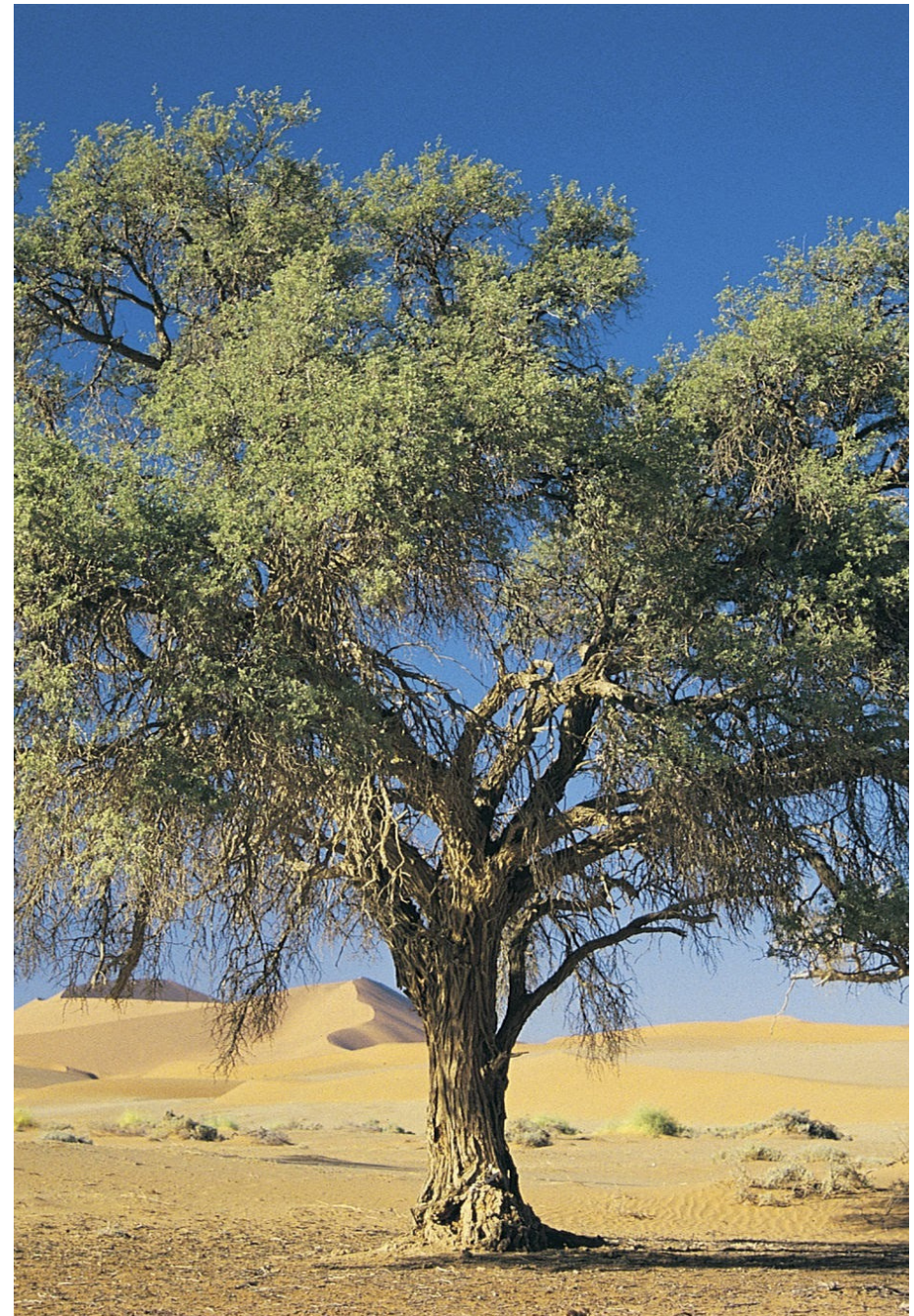
If you wish to **give online** rather than in the offering plate, please go to trinityrc.org/give/ or scan the QR code to the right to make your offering.
