




## CRAFT SHOW + QUILT RAFFLE

Dear Trinity Congregation,

I am Dianne Moker, and have been given the privilege of being the Endowment Committee Chair. Currently, our team consists of Nancy Ponstein, Bob Koning, Benji Garza and Sandy Bedard. This new team is looking at our endowment policies, how the money can be used and any adjustment that we feel needs to be made to ensure we are using this money for God's Glory. If you have any suggestions, please contact any one of these people on the committee.

The endowment funds are actually split into 6 sections.

Hamlink Ministries is for missional uses, we use this for supporting missionaries.

The Seminary Endowment is for Trinity members looking to go to Seminary or seminary interns working at Trinity.

Undesignated Memorial is from memorial gifts given to Trinity for general use.

We are entering into a new season for our next three endowment monies. Each year, monies are set aside from the investment of funds from the sale of the Chippewa Chapel in 2006. There are currently three "legs" to the Chippewa Endowment piece.

First, we are looking for ways to bless other ministry organizations. We set aside \$ for this purpose. We call this Community Partnership. If you know of a ministry who could be blessed from this money, please fill out a form.

Second, we set aside \$ for New Ministries or the enhancement of current ministries at Trinity. This is used as "seed money" for ministry within our Trinity Reformed Church group or to be used to enhance current ministries. We have used this money in various ways throughout the years, the most recent is our Children and Worship Coordinator.

Third, we set aside \$ for "Hands On" mission experiences. This has been used in the past for mission trips, projects such as the community garden or support of mission projects in the Holland area.

There are request forms for these last three endowment funds in the office, should you feel you have a good use of these monies, please fill out a request form.

The Endowment Committee has reviewed the policies, and will keep working to make sure we are good stewards of the amazing gifts God has given us.


